## TRANSCRIPT (SCHOOL RECORD) RELEASE -SENIORS ONLY

Moorestown High School has always honored student requests to forward transcripts.

Effective November 15, 1974, Federal and State Law prohibit the release of pupil records without parent or adult student written authorization. The school cannot release records without this written permission. Ref. New Jersey Administrative Code #6:3-6.1 states, "Organizations, agencies and persons from outside the school shall have access to pupil records if they have written consent of parent or adult pupil (age 18)".

Please be advised if you have applied to more than one college or university via the Common Application, **all** of their respective admissions offices will have access to **all** documents electronically submitted on your behalf. In the Common Application, you agreed to the following statement: *I acknowledge that every school that I have attended may release all requested records and recommendations to colleges to which I am applying for admission. I also understand that employees at these colleges may confidentially contact my current and former schools should they have any questions about the information submitted on my behalf.* 

<u>Please Note:</u> Due to the Score Choice option offered by the College Board, unofficial photocopies of SAT score reports are no longer included with the MHS transcript. Go to <u>www.collegeboard.com</u> for information on sending official score reports to colleges.
